OpenSFS Survey March 2019 Results

Background

A survey was developed and finalized during LWG meetings early in 2019. The intention was to collect information about Lustre usage across the community as input into the OpenSFS long-term support strategy.


Key Findings

- 82 respondents completed the survey compared to 110 in 2018, 70 in 2017, 97 in 2016, 89 in 2015, 76 in 2014, 73 in 2013 and 90 in 2012
- The Lustre 2.10.x LTS releases are the most widely used releases in production
- Ldiskfs storage accounts for about two thirds of the total capacity declared in the survey




2. What Linux distribution(s) do you use?

This question allowed multiple selections so the sum can exceed the total number of respondents.










The Other category suggested that Radio Astronomy and that the Meteorology category should be extended to include Climate Research.

9. What best describes your Lustre support situation?


